Event Format

Saturday (Day 1) –Shootdown Qualifier - (Max Score 600)
09:30 Registration Opens.
Two sessions of Shooting (1&2) – Timings, see above.

The Top 7 from RM, RW, CM, CW, LM, LW, BBM, BBW will go through to a "Shootdown" based on the total qualification score from Day 1 (600) + Day 2 (300). An additional "Joker" place will determine the 8th place in the shootdown.
- £100 voucher prize for each category.

USA/NFAA Style Vegas Round followed by a top 7 Shootdown, with a Joker Round for the eighth place.
5 Dozen arrows at 18m Distance on an Vegas face (Comp/Rec - 40cm Triple Special, LB/BB 40cm Single)
Scoring as per OBA Variant. (See separate OBA rule sheet)
Larger 27/64" arrows are permitted. Two details AB/CD, four faces per target. First 2.5 dozen AB top faces, Second 2.5 Dozen CD shoot on the top faces.
Music will be playing throughout (including shooting)
Flip number score boards and Electronic Scoring will be used.
Wall of fame for any "clean" 300 scoring target faces.
Though no formal equipment inspection is necessary, a Judge/Referee may inspect an Archers equipment at any point throughout the competition.

Shooting order for Day 2 will be posted on Day 1 and published on lanseo.

Saturday Evening - Nerves of Steel

Warm up is available in the hall for 30 minutes from 19:00 - 19:30 at 18m Targets

At 19:30 the Arena will close for reconfiguring ready for the Competition

Double detail for the first round, shooting a SINGLE arrow at a target faced with a steel plate with an aperture the size of an 8,9,10 and Compound 10 ring.

No archer will enter the target area to retrieve arrows. The field party will retrieve and inspect arrows.

If there is any damage to an arrow, including on the side of the shaft, the Archer is eliminated.

Once all Archers have shot, the remaining Archers with undamaged arrows will continue to the reduced size. Shooting arrows at steel plates could be dangerous - the tournament organiser will make all reasonable efforts to ensure the safety of both spectators and competitors involved - however a damage waiver will be required prior to shooting.

The Arena has plenty of space for spectators and refreshments are available throughout the evening. Music will be playing and both film cameras and photographers will be photographing the competitors whilst shooting.

Sunday (Day 2) –Shutdown Qualifier - (Max Score 300)

08:45 Warmup starts

Two sessions of shooting (1&2) – Timings, see above.

Lowest ranked archers shoot their final 300 round, to give a total 900 (Day1 + Day2)

Once the completed, the highest 150 ranked Archers will shoot their final 300 round.

Details AB/CD will rotate top/bottom target faces after 15 Arrows (5 Ends)

The SCAS Championships for Longbow, Barebow, Recurve and Compound (Men and Women) will be awarded on the highest qualification score in each category cumulative over the 600 Day1 and 300 Day2 (900 total) score.

SCAS Awards will be for the following:

Individual:

Gent & Lady - Highest Score for Recurve, Longbow, Barebow, Compound

Juniors (under 18) as above - Juniors will only be eligible for Junior Category unless entered as an Adult.

Team:

Highest scoring two or three person team (dependant on entry numbers and can be mixed teams) from one county - Can include Junior and Adult from one county.

Category: Compound, Recurve, Longbow.

Married couple: Award for “without”, and another for “with” a compound bow, from one county.

Joker Round: Everyone shooting has the chance of winning the 8th Spot in each category by shooting against all the other Archers who did not qualify in the top 7.

The Joker Round will be shot as followed:

- There is no practice end
- A single arrow will be shot on a spot of choice scoring regular scoring mode for each round, first round eliminates any Archer outside the Recurve 9, next round Recurve 10 etc.
- Longbow and barebow will share Single (not triple) faces.
- All archers tied for maximum score in the final round will shoot again scoring (CP X-9-9-8-7-6 & RC, LB, BB X-10-9-8-7-6)
- The archer with the closest to centre will advance to the final shoot-off.

Followed by the SHOOTDOWN.

The top 7 + Joker Archers in each division will shoot ends against each other with the top Archers in each end going through to determine the top 3. Rules to follow NFAA shutdown protocol for Vegas competition.

Scoring

Scoring on both days will be on lanseo three dozen score sheets and additionally with electronic scoring aids.

Awards

Medal awards will also be dependent on the number of entries per category.

Drug Testing

Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing.

Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply.

Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.

Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.

Lost Arrows	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.
Photography	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. Unauthorised photography is not permitted.
Special Note	Archers who are unable to get to the target should arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection or request from the tournament organiser prior to the competition.
Bosses	Tenzone Targets Layered foam bosses will be used for all classes.
Smoking	Designated smoking area outside the building. Please note that this rule applies to those using electronic cigarettes.
Stoves & Burners	No stoves or burners are permitted anywhere on-site
Pets	Please do not bring pets in the hotel / arena.
